## When Calling for Help:

- Have your address and phone number ready
- Explain your immediate need clearly
- Ask about eligibility requirements
- Request information about required documents
- Get the name of the person helping you
- Write down case numbers or reference numbers
- Ask when you can expect a response

#### **Documentation Often Needed:**

Photo ID

- Social Security cards for household members
- Proof of address (utility bill, lease)
- Proof of income (pay stubs, award letters)
- Birth certificates (for children's programs)

### **Stay Safe:**

- Trust your instincts
- If you feel unsafe, call 911
- Save this guide in an accessible place
- Share resources with others who may need help
